Many court leaders have been exposed to training on proficiencies from the National Association for Court Management. Some may have attended workshops from the National Center for State Courts' Institute for Court Management or taken university courses on judicial administration. Seasoned and successful court leaders do benefit from a variety of knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSAs).

This issue begins a series on different KSAs important to court leaders.
